



**Abriachan** lies between Drumnadrochit (4miles) and Inverness(9miles) on the A82. (Do not take the first turning marked Abriachan – only 1 mile from Inverness.)

There is an invaluable lay by on Loch Ness side, use it to turn up the steep hill to the Village Hall – in the Red Circle.

From the South turn right into this turning point and approach the steep hill up to the village by crossing the A82. The sign posts will guide you.

From the North there is a right turn across the A82.

The hall is on the right side of the road once it levels off – unmistakable with a red roof and grey corrugated iron walls – about 1 mile up from the A82.

If you are coming via Beaully/Kiltarlity/Foxhole the hall is on the left just before you start dropping down the hill to Loch Ness.

**Abriachan Forest Trust carpark is situated under the purple star by Loch Laide  
Grid Reference : NH540 354**

To get there uphill from the hall – travel past the hall 100m , take the left fork signposted Abriachan Forest Walks and keep going, passing Loch Laide on your left. Then two fields past the Loch, take the forest road on the left and the carpark is 400m on the left.
